RULES FOR THE COLLABORATORS OF THE MAGAZINE AGORA - TRUJILLO.

1. The magazine AGORA Trujillo, of the Universidad de Los Andes, Núcleo Universitario Rafael Rangel Trujillo, Venezuela, is defined as a scientific publication with an inter and trans-disciplinary character and semiannual appearance. Open to the researchers and scholars who wish to publish advances and results of investigations in the frame of Social and Human Sciences in its sections of: Economics, Education, Socio-History, Philosophy and Essay. The Publishing Committee reserves the conformation of the sections of the magazine in each edition according to the subject matters of the arbitrated papers existing in the data base.

2. The papers published in AGORA-Tujillo magazine are of complete responsibility of their authors and neither of the magazine nor of the sponsoring institutions.

3. The Publishing Committee of the AGORA-Trujillo magazine will only consider for publication, original and unpublished works that have not been simultaneously submitted in another scientific publications.

4. The papers must contain a communication addressed to the Director or Publishing Committee of the AGORA- Trujillo magazine, in which the consideration is requested and this will be submitted for arbitration. The communication must contain: The author(s) identification, address, telephones, e-mails and a brief résumé ,in no more than 20 lines.

5. Papers must be adapted to the forms and requirements established in the AGORA -Trujillo magazine for the arbitration process.

6. The papers received will be subject to arbitration or evaluation in order to determine the feasibility of publication according to criteria of relevance, originality, methodological techniques and scientific level and procedures conventionally accepted.

7. The author or authors with residence in Venezuela, must submit or send the work in original and a printed copy with the version on CD; written in Word, point Times New Roman, 12 font; and fully paginated; to the following address:

8. The paper must have a maximum of 18 pages, using 1.5 spaces, including tables, figures, or photographs, no more than 4.

9. The paper must contain an abstract in Spanish and English, of 12 lines at the most, and between 3 and 5 keywords. It should include: purpose or objective, methodology, results and conclusions.

10. In the bibliographical references the authors or institutions mentioned in the body of the paper or article must be indicated . For the elaboration of those, the APA standards in its latest edition must be followed, for instance:

13. The Publishing Committee of the Agora Trujillo magazine has the right to do the adjustments and changes of form than the article or paper requires, to assure the quality of the publication.

14. The Magazine will not return original papers.
